## **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

- Maximum of two rods per person.
- Fishing is only allowed with rod and line. One hook only per line.
- All under 18's must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- All anglers must be in possession of a current, valid E.A. Rod licence.
- No rods to be left unattended at any time.
- No fishing in the ornamental lake or boating lake.
- Minimum 12lb line when carp/pike fishing.
- One landing net is required per angler (no sharing).
- Carp angler's minimum size landing net is 42".
- Large, padded, unhooking mats are compulsory for all anglers. Under no circumstances are fish
  to be placed directly on the ground.
- No fixed lead rigs. All leads must pass freely over leader knots.
- No braided mainline.
- No artificial bait.
- No swimming, bathing, wading or tree climbing.
- No keepnets or carp sacks. All fish must be returned to the fishery alive, and as soon as possible, into the swim they were caught from.
- Please help us keep the park clear of litter and lines etc. Anglers are responsible for litter in and around their swim.
- No radios or firearms permitted. (Responsible bait boat use only)
- No fires or BBQ's permitted.
- Please keep footpaths clear.
- Please respect wildlife, surrounding areas, other anglers and park users at all times.
- Officially appointed bailiffs and the E.A. will carry out regular patrols, ticket checks and rig checks and fish conservation advice.
- No alcohol or drugs are permitted at any time. Immediate bans follow.
- Failure to leave the premises before the gates close may result in a fine at the discretion of the management.
- Anglers wishing to night fish will be required to buy a yearly membership card prior to their first fish.

## **Night Fishing**

- Night fishing is restricted to the big lake only.
- Night fishing is for over 18's only, unless at the manager's discretion.
- Night anglers are required to pay an annual membership fee and will be issued with a membership card.
- Lost cards will incur a £10 renewal fee.
- Night fishing must be booked in advance and as numbers are limited these places will be subject to availability.

Jake's staff and bailiffs will enforce the fishing rules and reserve the right to cancel, revoke or refuse entry (without refund). Any angler who is found to be in breach of the fishery rules will be asked to leave.
