



# Fishing Terms and Conditions

## Night Fishing Terms and Conditions

- **Night fishers are required to pay an annual membership and will be issued with a membership card. This is in addition to the cost of each fish.**
  - **Night fishing is restricted to the big lake only.**
  - **Night fishing is for over 18' only, unless at the manager's discretion.**
  - **Lost cards will incur a £10 renewal fee**
  - **Night fishing must be booked in advance and as numbers are limited these places will be subject to availability.**
  - **All other normal terms and conditions of fishing, shown below, will still apply.**
  - *Jake's staff and bailiffs will enforce the fishing rules and reserve the right (without refund) to cancel, revoke or refuse entry. Any angler who is found to be in breach of the fishery rules will be asked to leave.*

- Maximum of two rods per person
  - All under 18's must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
  - All anglers must be in possession of a current, valid E.A. Rod Licence
  - No rods to be left unattended at any time
  - No fishing in the ornamental lake or boating lake (close to the main building)
  - Only barbed hooks are permitted – NO bent hooks
  - One landing net is permitted per angler (no sharing)
  - Carp angler's minimum sized landing net 42"
  - Large, padded unhooking mats are compulsory for all anglers. Under no circumstances are fish to be placed directly on the ground
  - No permanently fixed leads
  - No swimming, wading, bathing or tree climbing.
  - No keepnets or carp sacks. All fish must be returned to the fishery alive, as soon as possible, into the swim they were caught from
  - Please help us to keep the park clear of litter, lines etc. Anglers are responsible for litter in and around their swim
  - No radios or firearms permitted. (sensible bait boat use only)
  - No fires or Barbeques permitted.
  - Please keep footpaths clear
  - Please respect the wildlife, surrounding areas and other anglers and park users at all times
  - Please vacate any disabled pegs if required
  - Officially appointed bailiffs and the E.A. will carry out regular patrols, ticket checks and rig checks and fish conservation advice.
  - No alcohol or drugs are permitted at any time
